

ELIGIBILITY: This is an exhibit of fine craft: clay, fiber, glass, paper, leather, metal/jewelry, wood and mixed media. No painting, drawing or photography.

Sizes: Wall pieces no larger than 40" high x 30" wide including frame. No heavier than 40 lbs. Size: 3-D pieces 8" high maximum to fit in display cases (Jericho only). NO free-standing 3-D work and no pedestals.

SPECIFICATIONS: All accepted work must be suitably prepared for gallery display. 2-D wall work must be wired tightly within the top third of the frame. No saw-tooth hangers. Work that is unstable, damaged, does not meet the specified conditions, or does not correspond to the submitted image is not acceptable.

Work that requires elaborate installation, presents a hazard to the institution or the public, requires routine maintenance after installation or contains foodstuffs or potentially damaging components will not be considered.

Submission to this exhibit constitutes an agreement by the artist to the listed terms and conditions. All work must have been created within the past 3 years and not previously exhibited with LICG.

NOTE: The wall pieces ONLY from this exhibit will travel to the Great Neck Public Library, 159 Bayview Ave. for a reprise exhibit November 1 – December 12. Artists will be responsible for removing their work from Jericho on October 31 from 10:00 – 12:00 and delivering it to Great Neck the same day 10:30 – 2:30.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS: IMAGES

JPEGs via email to sjshore@optonline.net labeled with artist's last name, first initial, title (e.g., Jones P Pufferbelly.jpg). Image size of at least 2000 pixels on longest side. 3-D work may include second view. Put "Anything Goes" in subject line of email.

EXHIBITION JUROR:

Naomi Grossman is a mixed media artist working in Long Island City. She does wire sculptures that reference the human body and function as drawings in space as well as works on paper. Her work brings up issues of aging, loss, displacement, isolation, insecurity and the desire for connection and love.

One-person shows include **Art of the Five - Queens Select:** Invitational at the Interchurch Center, NYC, **Sometimes Beautiful** – catalogue - Castellani Art Gallery, Niagara University, **Writing the Body** at the Queens College Art Center, **Body Language:** one-person exhibit and visiting artist at the Freyberger Museum, Penn State University and a show and a visiting artist at the Phillips Museum, Franklin & Marshall College, PA.

Grossman has produced site-specific installations in gallery settings. Residencies include the Ragdale Foundation and the Hambidge Center for the Arts. Her awards include best in show at the Parrish Art Museum, MARK Grant and numerous SOS grants from NYFA. She is a One-on-One Consultant for NYFA. Grossman's work is in numerous permanent public and private collections.

She has been showing her work at the Diana Felber Gallery in West Stockbridge MA and at the St. Francis Gallery in Great Barrington, MA.

Grossman was born in Brooklyn and works in Long Island City, NY. She attended Queens College (BA) and New York University (MA).
